



Research Real Estate Agent Production Online in 5 Minutes

These are non-MLS agent production online search methods that apply for most if not all U.S. States.

Goal: Find agents' annual sales volume to date, and if available find their total units closed to date.

Step 1: Start with Zillow (Fastest Overview)

- 1. Go to zillow.com
- 2. Click "Agent finder" (top menu)
- 3. Search by agent name + city/state
- 4. On their profile → Scroll to "Past Sales"
 - Shows: # of homes sold, total \$ volume, average price
 - Covers last 12–24 months this search criteria may be built in and not editable so don't worry if the information provided is beyond the current year - just note this in your spreadsheet.
 - Tip: If there is concern over accuracy, click each sale to verify details

Step 2: Cross-Check on Realtor.com (Most Accurate)

- 1. Go to realtor.com
- 2. Click "Find Realtors"
- 3. Search agent name + location
- 4. View "Sales History" tab
 - Updated directly from local MLS
 - Often shows faster and more complete data than Zillow

Step 3: Use Redfin (Best for Speed & Comparisons)

- 1. Go to redfin.com
- 2. Click "Find an Agent"
- 3. Search agent name or zip code
- 4. See "Homes Sold" + "Faster than X% of agents"
 - Great for side-by-side agent rankings









Step 4: Verify with Public Records (100% Free & Unfiltered)

- Google: "[County Name] property records search"
- (e.g., "Miami-Dade property records")
- Use official county site or NETROnline.com
- Search by agent's name (as buyer's or seller's agent)
- Count recent deed recordings to confirm volume
 - Note: Only shows closed sales, not listings

Using Your MLS for agent production research:

- Most MLS systems have an "agent roster" or "agent search" option where you can usually find accurate agent production information.
- MLS systems are similar as their function is similar, however, navigation can vary.
- Keep in mind agent production for agents working on a team may not report accurately because often team production is recorded under the name of the team or the name of the owner/leader agent.
- If you use the MLS to research agent production, also using another online source such as Zillow or Realtor.com to cross reference data, is recommended as a best practice.
